I would recommend that you do not watch the movies before you read the books.

Wonder by R.J. Palacio is a book set in the real world. It is the story of a fictional boy named Auggie Pullman who has a disability called Treacher Collins Syndrome, a facial difference. Auggie has a difficult journey through school with kids bullying and ignoring him.

Wonder is a heart-wrenching book that made me want to burst into tears. I loved the part in the field when Auggie ran away from the bullies and his friends were by his side. I would recommend this book for ages 8 years and up.

Wonder is a movie filmed in British Columbia, Canada, and Coney Island, New York from July 18 to September 13, 2016. Auggie is played by Jacob Tremblay. This movie follows a similar storyline to the book but is missing key parts. The movie ruined the characters' images in my head but besides that, it was an okay movie. Again I recommend you read the book before you watch the movie.



The Positive Impact on the Environment

In the November newsletter, I explained how eating a plant-based diet can significantly improve your health. Now, I'll discuss another benefit of a plant-based diet: how it can lessen your impact on the environment.

The environmental impact of food and agriculture is substantial. The publication "World in Data" reports that food accounts for over a quarter (26%) of global greenhouse gas emissions. This includes livestock, fisheries, crop production, land use and supply chains (food processing).

As a single food, beef has the greatest negative impact on our environment. Producing beef requires around 28 times more land and 11 times more water than other food categories and results in 5 times more greenhouse gas emissions. When comparing beef to other staples such as wheat or rice, the impact of beef per calorie is 160 times more land and 11 times more greenhouse gases.

> In a study by the University of Oxford, researchers found that meat-rich diets - defined as more than 100g per day- resulted in 7.2kg of carbon dioxide emissions. In contrast, both vegetarian and fish-eating diets caused about 3.8kg of CO2 per day, while vegan diets produced only 2.9kg. Another study from the UK on

greenhouse gas emissions and diet found that eating a vegetarian diet rather than an animal-based diet cut emissions by half.

There are many ways to reduce your environmental impact by the food choices you make. Here are a few recommendations:

1. Eat meat-free meals

· Try to eat at least one meat-free meal per day, maybe two or three somedays.

2. Buy organic and local whenever possible

- · Organic food is better for the climate. It's grown without genetically modified organisms. Because organic animal-based foods aren't fed antibiotics or hormones, they're typically more nutritious, containing more vitamins and minerals.
- · Try purchasing a share to support Community Support Agriculture (CSA). Clarity partners with Nichols Farm - so your food comes to Western Springs and it's local, fresh and grown sustainably!

3. Don't waste food

· Close to half of all food produced worldwide is wasted. Try composting in your backyard. This saves on the amount of trash being transported and can be used in your garden!

4. Grow your own

· Growing fruits, vegetables and herbs at home makes their trip to your table shorter. You can also grow your own food without chemicals.

In addition to all of the health benefits of a plant-based diet (lowers blood pressure, improves heart-health and cholesterol profile, and helps prevent Type II diabetes and certain cancers), plantbased eating can also help reduce your environmental impact.

Companies[TT1] without these designations do not always employ safe practices and should be avoided. Bartlett Tree Experts follow OSHA guidelines.







Cake:

- · 1 c. chopped pecans
- 1 18oz. yellow cake mix
- 1 3 3/4oz.vanilla instant pudding
- 4 eggs
- $\frac{1}{2}$ c. cold water
- ½ c. Canola oil
- ½ c. 80 proof Rum (I used Rum from Trinidad)



- 4 T. butter (1/2 stick)
- 2 T. water
- ½ c. granulated sugar
- 1/4 c. Rum



- Preheat oven to 325*
- Assemble ingredients & spray 10 " Angel Food (Tube) Pan with Pam
- · Chop 1 c. pecans & sprinkle in bottom of Angel Food pan
- · Mix all of cake ingredients for 2 min.
- · Pour batter over ch. Pecans in pan
- · Use a pizza pan cookie sheet under Angel Food pan in case of leaks
- Bake at 325* for 1 hour
- Cool cake for at least an hour & then carefully remove from pan to plate



- Meanwhile prepare Glaze; also poke holes in top of cake with 2 prong fork gently (so as not to ruin the crunchy top)
- When cake is almost cool, mix the first 3 ingredients in small saucepan
- Boil for 5 min. stirring constantly
- Remove from heat & stir in Rum
- After piercing cake with fork, brush the hot glaze over top & sides of cake until all of the glaze is used up-let cake sit & dry a bit.

If not serving soon, wrap cake in plastic or foil & store in refrigerator. It will keep for at least a week or more.

When serving, top each slice with Cool Whip or whipped cream and shaved chocolate. It's a treat your guests will long remember.




